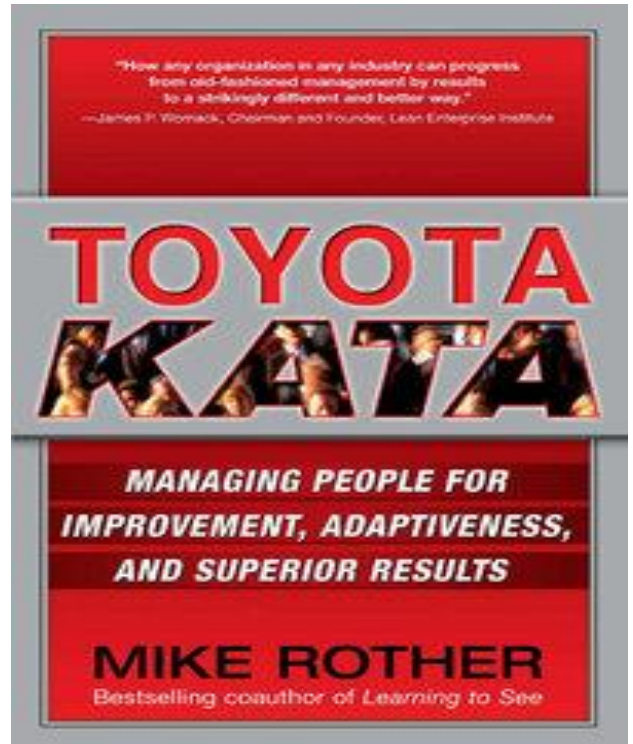


# NORTHERN MICHIGAN LEAN LEARNING CONSORTIUM
